

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

There are numerous scholarships available through the National Federation of Music Clubs. Scholarships are available for JUNIORS – through high school age students; STUDENTS – college age students; and SENIORS – teachers. Here is an overview of them. Notice that there are piano, instrumental, orchestral, vocal, dance, and composition awards. Feel free to give this information to any interested student or teacher.

For most of the scholarships:

Membership in NFMC is required. Students may pay a fee to join NFMC at the time of the application.

Entry is free, or a very nominal charge.

The cash award amount is to be used for music study.

Each scholarship has unique requirements. (Some require applicants to be U.S. citizens.) Consult with Peggy Schlieker or the website for the specific scholarships you are interested in.

NOTICE: The age requirements for juniors, students, and seniors sometimes over-lap. Be sure to read through all the scholarships.
